## **Introduction**

If you are reading this you will have realised that we would like to sign **you** or your **son/daughter** for the coming season 2015/16. The next few sections of this welcome pack give details that you and or your child need to be aware of before you make up your mind whether to sign for Hamble United FC or not. We obviously hope you do decide to sign, if you have any questions please contact the appropriate manager.

## **Training**

Training can be twice a week depending on the Manager.

Adult teams train:

Tuesday evenings 18:30 - 20:00

Thursday evenings 18:30 - 20:00

Tyro and Mini soccer teams normally train: as

One evening per week 18:00 to 19:30

Saturday mornings 10:00 to 11:30

During the winter, Saturdays will stay the same, but the midweek session may have to change so that we can use floodlights. You will be given plenty of warning when this happens. There may also be an additional charge for winter training venues.

If a player is unable to make a training session or a match, then they or a parent **must** phone to let the manager know A.S.A.P.

## **Kit Allocation**

Each player has been given one set of home Kit (red/black) consisting of shirt, shorts and socks. This kit should not be used for any other reason other than playing for Hamble United FC. The kit is not to be worn for training sessions.

Other clothing that has been purchased by means of fundraising or sponsorship by the Club can include, tracksuit, rain jacket and drill tops and must be worn at all activities that are for or on behalf of Hamble United FC this may include matches, tournaments, sponsored events, training etc. This list of clothing may be added to as and when funds are available.

All kit is to be kept in good/clean condition and the manufacturers have advised that all kit should be ironed inside out and never tumble dried to prevent any of the logos from peeling.

**All kit purchased by the Club, belongs to Hamble United FC and must be returned at the end of every season or when a player leaves the Club.**

## **Club Social events**

It is our intension to have regular social events for players, parents and family members. Although attendance is not compulsory I would like to think most if not all players and their families would support these events, as all money raised is for the benefit of the Club and hence its player.

## **Substitutes**

I know this can be a difficult subject so we have decided to set some ground rules. Firstly **no player is guaranteed to start or play in every game.**

U18's and Adult teams are not allowed rolling substitutions; you are only allowed to play **three of five named substitutes** which means two players at least will not play.

**Team selection will be based on:**

1. Attitude and ability (during training and matches).
2. On the individual team we will be playing.
3. Formation we choose to play.
4. Players available for each position.

**Substitutions can be made for a number of reasons:**

1. Player having a bad day.
2. Change of formation.
3. Tactical.
4. Injuries. (Hopefully not too many)

If any player or parent is not happy with the amount of football they are playing or the way the team is selected, please speak to the Manager, it is far better to sort these problems out early rather than later, as it is disruptive to see parents 'moaning' on the sidelines. It also does the player no good to see his/her parent(s) unhappy.

Unfortunately someone has to choose the team and that is the Manager. We know they will not always get it right or make everyone happy. But they will always field what they think is their best side and will always try as far as possible to give players a fair amount of football. If on the odd occasion they do not make a change or give everyone a game, it will be because they have tried to do the best for the Team. So please try not to take it personally.

## **Conduct**

Included with this pack are the codes of conduct that players, parents and supporters are expected to follow. Any complaints regarding match officials and opponents must be reported to the team manager. Who will if necessary progress the complaint.



## Respect Code of conduct for Youth players

Fair play and respect for all others in the game is fundamentally important.

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. As a player, you have a big part to play. That's why The FA is asking every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct.

### When playing football, I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability
- Play fairly - I won't cheat, complain or waste time.
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee or my coach/manager.
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee
- Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
- Listen and respond to what my coach/team manager tells me
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or the FA.

### I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, and referee or team manager
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Be required to leave the club.

### In addition:

- My club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct
- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club



## Respect Code of conduct for Parents/Carers and Spectators

Ensure that parents/spectators within your club are always positive and encouraging towards all of the children not just their own.

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

This club is supporting The FA's Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment. Remember children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything. Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers at all times.

### **I will:**

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake - mistakes are part of learning
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA, league or The FA.

### **I may be:**

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Required to meet with the club, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Required to meet with the club committee
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Requested by the club not to attend future games
- Suspended or have my club membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents.

### **In addition:**

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club
